HISTORY OF COLLEGE

Govt. Islamia Graduate College for Women, Cooper Road, Lahore was established in 1939 at Intermediate level. The college was a beacon of light for learning which opened its doors for young women to get higher education at that time, without any discrimination of creed, race or religion. It is worth mentioning that the college has the singular distinction of having been visited by the father of the nation "**Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah and Mohtarma Fatima Jinnah on 26th March, 1944.**" The students of this college actively participated in the Pakistan Movement and kindled a torch which guided the Muslim women of the region towards progressive Pakistan. Govt. Islamia Graduate College for Women, Cooper Road, Lahore has always promoted and provided opportunities for the curricular and co-curricular activities for its students. To meet the ever increasing academic and non-academic needs, new buildings and blocks were added. In 1952, the commodious Shuja-ud-Din Hall was built. The Science Block (Botany & Zoology) and College Library were built during the year 1986-87 and a new Academic Block called Urdu Block was built in 1993-94.

In the year 2010, BS-4 Year Degree Program was introduced and college was affiliated **with Lahore College for Women University, Lahore for BS 4-Year Degree Program.** In 2011, the construction of BS Block was completed and well equipped Computer Labs were added in 2012-2013 by Higher Education Department, Govt. of the Punjab. In the year 2014-2015, two more computer labs were established. Internet and computer facilities have been provided to many departments to give the students and faculty an access to advanced sources of knowledge.

Alumnae:

The college has a long list of old students who have been contributing to the society in various positions like doctors, engineers, business administrators, software engineers etc. Some noteworthy names are as under:

Begum Fatima Sugra:

Fatima Sugra also known as Sugra Begum a Pakistani activist. She was the student of Govt. Islamia Graduate College for Women, Cooper Road, Lahore. In February 1947, Fatima Sugra pulled down the British Union Jack from the Civil Secretariat Lahore and hoisted the Muslim League flag. This act became a big symbol of independence for which she was rewarded a gold medal in 1987.

Ms. Shaista Anjum completed her BS English Language & literature from Govt. Islamia Graduate College for Women, Cooper Road, Lahore and is serving in Postal Services after Passing CSS.

■ **Hafiza Qaria Rubina:** ●

Hafiza Qaria Rubina, a globally renowned Qaria, was a Professor of Arabic in Govt. Islamia Graduate College for Women, Cooper Road, Lahore from September 2010 till her death in 2017. She received more than 400 national and international awards. She was the only woman Qaria to have received Pride of Performance from the Government of Pakistan and the title "Chota Basit" from Qari Abdul Basit himself.

BS-4YDP (FOUR YEAR DEGREE PROGRAM)

Govt. Islamia Graduate College for Women, Cooper Road, Lahore is offering BS Four Year Degree Program with minimum 134 credit hours divided into 8 Semesters with 02 Semesters each year. This program will equip students to pursue further higher education and enable them to meet national demands and international challenges in the rapidly changing world scenario.

ADMISSION RULES

Procedure:

For year I (semester I & II), the academic session starts in October and concludes in July whereas for the last three academic years (semesters III to VIII), the academic session starts in September and ends in May (tentatively). Admission to BS-4YDP is made according to the schedule advertised in the leading newspapers. The merit lists of candidates selected provisionally are displayed on the College Notice Board. The selected candidates must pay admission dues within the notified dates. If they fail to do so, their admission shall stand cancelled.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

1. All admissions are made on merit.
2. Student must have 50% marks to apply for BS-4YDP affiliated with LCWU and 45% marks for BS-4YDP affiliated with GCU, Lahore
3. As per the directions of the Government of Punjab, before the announcement of the result of Intermediate Part II.
 - Candidates are eligible to apply on the basis of F.A/F.Sc A-Level 1st year result.
 - Admissions will be finalized after the submission of F.A/F.Sc A-Level complete result.
4. After the announcement of the result (Inter Part-II), candidates will apply on the basis of complete result.
5. Admissions to Computer Science, Micro Biology, BBA, B.Com. and B.ED Secondary Education will be purely conditional. The students must achieve 60% marks to meet the criterion of GCU (for Micro Biology) or standards of accreditation for the rest of the subject after producing the complete Intermediate Part –II result.
6. The candidates will be fully responsible for submitting the complete result of Intermediate Part-II to the admission committee/concerned department. In case of any issue in future, the student will be solely responsible for it.

- F.Sc. Pre Medical, F.A with Psychology, A Level /equivalent qualification

Eligibility Criteria B.Com & BBA

- F.A (Mathematics/Statistics/Economics), F.Sc. (Pre-Medical/Pre-Engineering), I.COM/ I.C.S / A-Levels or any equivalent qualifications

Eligibility Criteria BS Chemistry

- F.Sc, Pre Medical, F.Sc. Pre Engineering, A-Level

Eligibility Criteria BS Computer Science

- ICS Physics, ICS G.Sc. F.Sc Pre-Engineering, A-Level or having equivalent qualification.



- It is compulsory to have studied Mathematics at Intermediate level to apply for BS Computer Science/

Eligibility Criteria BS Economics

- F.A with Economics, G.Sc, I.Com, I.C.S, F.Sc. (Pre- Engineering, Pre-Medical)

Eligibility Criteria BS English Literature & Language/TESOL

- F.A, F.Sc, A Level at least 50% Marks in English Language.
- Candidates have to qualify Admission Test for BS English Literature & Language & Interview for BS TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages)

Eligibility Criteria B.Ed Secondary

- F.A, F.Sc, I.C.S, G. Science, I.Com or any equivalent qualification
- Minimum 60% Marks in intermediate

Eligibility Criteria BS Islamic Studies/BS Political Science/BS Urdu/BS Social Work

- F.A , F.Sc., G.Sc ,ICS, I Com. any equivalent qualification.

Eligibility Criteria BS Zoology

- F.Sc, Pre Medical or equivalent

Open Merit

98% seats are filled on open merit.

RESERVED SEATS

The applicant must meet the minimum eligibility criteria for admission set for open merit for reserved seats as well.

Minority Quota

- 2% minority seats are reserved in overall BS admission.
- Original documentation (Diocese, Gurdhwara, Mandir, etc.) will have to be submitted to the college committee which has the right to determine the eligibility.

Hifz-e-Quran Quota

- 2% seats are reserved for the Hifz-e-Quran in overall BS admission.
- It is compulsory to bring *Wafaq-ul-Mudaris Certificate* / Certificate of Madrassa, at the time of test.
- Twenty marks will be added to the marks obtained in HSSC/A-Level/Equivalent in case the candidate passes oral test.

Disability Quota

- 2% seats are reserved for the disabled in overall BS admission.
- Physical disability means disability that cannot be rectified by any equipment. Being short sighted and hard of hearing does not fall under the definition of disability for admission purpose.
- The candidates must enclose with their admission forms the certificate of their physical disability duly signed by the M.S. Services Hospital Lahore / PSRD, Ferozpur Road, Lahore.



Sports Quota

1. As per rules set by LCWU, sports quota is reserved only in faculty of Social Sciences, Education and Languages.
2. At the time of sports trials, the students must bring their original documents; otherwise they will not be allowed to appear in selection trials.
3. At the time of admission, students applying for BS will submit an affidavit duly signed by parents and students that original documents will be kept in the college for 4 years, and the students are bound to attend all sports sessions as per requirement of sports department.
4. Eligibility of admission on sports quota basis in each department will be determined by each respective teaching department itself.

NOTE: No seat/ Sports quota is reserved for the Faculty of Science and Technology.

- g. CNIC of candidate's Father/Guardian
- h. Monthly Income Certificate of Father/Guardian.
- i. No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the parent board (in case of transfer/migration from a board other than Lahore Board. NOC can be submitted within two weeks of admission).
- j. Health Proforma attached with the prospectus
- k. Roll. No. slip of Second Year Exam (in case of admission on the basis of 1st year result)

EXAMINATION SYSTEM

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTIONS

The medium of instructions and examination in Lahore College for Women University Lahore (affiliated colleges) shall be English except in the case of Pakistani/ Regional/ Foreign/ oriental languages where Pakistani/ Regional/ Foreign/ oriental language may be used along with English.

WEIGHTAGE OF MARKS

The weightage of marks for each course in a Semester shall be as under.

Sr. No.	Internal Assessment	
1.	Mid Semester Test	30%
2.	Sessional Work	20%
3.	Final Examination	50%
	Total	100%

The course instructor shall be responsible for the allocation of sessional work (i.e. topics for quizzes/ assignments/ presentations etc.) at the start of each semester.

Separate Practical Papers will be set for the courses with practical work as a module. Weightage shall be determined by the respective statuary body.

MID SEMESTER TEST

In the Ninth week of the Semester a Mid Semester Test will be conducted, without disturbing the teaching schedule.

A student has to appear in the Mid Semester Test of each course in a semester, failing which she shall be awarded "F" grade in that course and such student shall have to repeat the course along with forthcoming semester.

ATTENDANCE CRITERIA

- A student must attend **80 percent** of the lectures delivered in each course in a semester to be eligible to appear in the Final Examination of that course.
- The **list of Eligible candidates** for the Final Examination shall be notified to the controller office by the Chairperson of the respective Department **before the start** of Final Examination of each Semester.
- In case a student **does not attend 80% of the lectures** delivered in any course/s in a Semester, **she will not be allowed to appear** in the Final Examination of that course/s.
- She will be **awarded "I" (Incomplete) grade** in such course/s. Such students will have to repeat the concerned course/s in a forthcoming Semester which offers the course/s.
- Medical leave shall not be considered towards attendance.

Note: Parents are directed to check the class Whatsapp groups of all teacher for important notices.

FINAL EXAMINATION OF SEMESTER

- There will be a Final Examination **at the end of each Semester** covering the **whole prescribed syllabus** for each course.



CRITERIA TO QUALIFY THE SEMESTER

- A student shall pass the course if she scores **at least 50% marks** in the Semester Work and Final Examination combined.
- "F" grade shall be awarded to a student, who was eligible to appear in the Final Examination of course(s) of any semester but,
- fails to appear in the Mid Semester Test and/or
- fails to appear in Final Examination of any course(s) and/or
- does not have at least 50% marks in Internal Assessment and Final Examination combined,
- Such student shall have to get herself enrolled for repeating the said course(s) in the forthcoming semesters and shall be allowed to appear in all the Assessments (Internal as well as Final Examinations) given by the respective course instructor.
- **No grace marks** will be awarded to the students.
- A student who fails to score **at least 1.50 CGPA** after any Semester will be required to get Re-admission in the program.
- **Re-admission** in Program is **allowed only once**. The fee for university re-admission will be **Rs 1000/-**.
- A student who gets re-admission in the program shall get exemption for the course(s) which she has qualified with grade equal to or higher than "C+". Such student shall have to complete the Degree within maximum duration allowed

PROBATION

- A student who scores **CGPA between 1.50 and 2.00** in a Semester will be conditionally promoted to the next semester and will be placed on **First Probation**.
- In case she **fails to score 2.00 CGPA after the Semester of First Probation**, another chance will be granted and she will be placed on **Last Probation**.
- In case she **fails to score 2.00 CGPA after the semester of Last Probation**, she shall have to get Re-admission in the program.
- A student, who remains **absent** or **fails** to qualify **all the courses of a semester**, shall **not be allowed** to continue in the next semester. Such student may be allowed to re-join the same semester along with the following session only, subject to the maximum length of the program.

AWARD OF DEGREE

- A BS student has to complete **at least 130 - 140** credit hours.
- For BS one has to score at least **2.30 CGPA at the end of Program**.
- The **maximum duration** allowed to a student for the completion of BS Degree is **Six years**.
- Degree will be handed over only to the student. No relative (male/female) can collect the degree in any case.

SEMESTER FREEZE

- A student may take a Semester off due to unavoidable circumstances (e.g. Financial/ Health Constraints etc.) by applying for a Semester Freeze.



- Such student must submit an application within First Two weeks of the start of Semester. The application must be verified by the Chairperson of the respective department/ Principal of the Affiliated Institution before submission to the Controller of Examinations for notification. The student will re-join the same Semester in the following academic year subject to the maximum duration as per the Examination Regulations of the program.
- The duration of Semester Freeze shall be counted towards maximum duration allowed for the completion of respective degree

RECHECKING OF ANSWER SCRIPT

- A student can apply to the Controller of Examinations for rechecking of the answer script of Final Examination of a Semester/ Academic Year within 15 days of the date of declaration of result, on prescribed Proforma after payment of prescribed fee.

PAYMENT OF FEE AND OTHER DUES

- The college fee, hostel fee, funds and other dues must be paid on the dates notified by the college at the Bank Counter established in college premises. The Challan Form will be issued by the college office only. Candidates who fail to pay their dues within the due date will lose their right of admission.
- After payment of dues at the time of new admission, the student must contact the staff on duty for allotment of Roll No. and section slip otherwise her admission will be cancelled.
- The fee for BS-4YDP is non-refundable after submission.

FINANCIAL AID

- Financial Aid to the students of semester-I will be provided on the basis of their attendance of two months and result of mid-term exams.
- Financial Assistance is available to the students on merit as well as merit-cum need basis from semester II.
- 50% concession in tuition fee is granted to the younger sister, in case two real sisters are studying in the college.
- Fee concession is also available to teacher's daughter.
- Financial Aid is granted to Orphan students.
- Financial Aid is available for the needy under the Heads of Zakat, Bait-ul-Maal, and Education Endowment Fund.

All these concessions are granted for one semester only but continue on the condition that the performance and behavior of the students is satisfactory.

CM PUNJAB'S HONHAR SCHOLARSHIP AND LAPTOP SCHEME

Under CM Punjab's Honhar Scholarship Program, full fee of all eight semesters of BS programs is provided as scholarship to the students of public sector colleges. In the session 2024-25, 82 students of Government Islamia Graduate College for Women, Cooper Road, Lahore achieved Honhar Scholarship in two phases of the scheme. 56 students of the college received laptops in the CM Punjab's Laptop Scheme announced for the students of Government colleges only.

ATTENDANCE CRITERIA GOVT. COLLEGE UNIVERSITY

1.1 A student must attend at least 80 percent of the lectures delivered in each course in a semester to be eligible to appear in the Final Examination of that course.

1.2 In case a student does not attend at least 80% of the lectures delivered in any course(s) in a Semester, s/he shall not be allowed to appear in the Final Examination of that course(s).

GENERAL CRITERIA FOR QUALIFYING A SEMESTER (GCU)

2.1 Every student has to complete Semester Work and take the Final Examination offered by the University in each Semester.

2.2 In case a student does not complete the Semester Work or does not appear in the Final Examination s/he will be awarded an "F" grade in that course and such student shall have to take re-admission in the course(s).

2.3 A student shall pass a course if s/he scores at least 40% marks in the Semester Work and Final Examination combined, subject to the fulfilment of the condition given in 2.5.1 and 2.5.1.1.

2.4 No grace marks shall be awarded to the students.

2.5 A student, who fails to score a minimum of 1.50 CGPA at the end of any semester, shall have to get Re-admission in the Program i.e. First Semester, subject to the maximum length of the program i.e. six years.

2.6 A student who scores CGPA between 1.50 and 2.00 at the end of any semester; shall be placed on First Probation. Such student shall be conditionally promoted to the next semester.

2.7 In case a student fails to score 2.00 CGPA in the Semester of First Probation, another chance shall be given to such student. S/he shall be conditionally promoted to the next Semester and shall be placed on Last Probation.

2.8 In case a student fails to score 2.00 CGPA in the semester of Last Probation s/he shall have to get Re-admission in the Program i.e. First Semester, subject to the maximum length of the program i.e. six years.

2.9 Re-admission in Program is only allowed once.



- 2.10 A student who gets re-admission in the program shall get exemption for the course(s) which s/he has qualified with grade equal to or higher than "C+". Such student shall have to complete the Degree within Six years from the first admission to the program.
- 2.11 A student who scores "F" grade in any course(s) in a Semester, shall have to get re-admission in the concerned course(s) along with the forthcoming semester when these course(s) are offered by the University, provided that s/he is not debarred
- 2.12 A student can be given only one chance to improve a course with grade less than "C+". The improvement is only possible by repeating the course(s) along with the forthcoming semester which offers the course(s), provided that s/he is not debarred
- 2.13 A student, who remains absent or fails to qualify all the courses of a semester, will not be allowed to continue in the next semester. Such student may be allowed to rejoin the same semester along with the following session only, subject to the maximum length of the program, i.e. six years.





GENERAL RULES

COLLEGE UNIFORM

Proper college uniform is compulsory and students will not be granted permission to enter the college in colored clothes.

- White dupatta (1.5-inch specified semester ribbon on all sides)

- Ribbon in Prescribed colors can be purchased from the college canteen.
- Black-, white- or skin-coloured socks
- Black shoes

2. Winter Uniform:

- Black Sweater (no black shawl/cape shawl, coat is allowed)

Note: Students who choose to wear head scarf, will only use college specified dupattas for this purpose.

COLLEGE CARDS

College cards are issued to all the students at the time of admission. Students will not be allowed to enter the college without showing their college cards. They are required to keep their cards with them at all times. If a student fails to produce her card on demand by the teaching staff, she will be fined. In case of loss of cards, a duplicate card will be issued on payment of Rs. 100/-

LEAVE RULES

1. Leave is granted only in case of genuine need.
2. Leave up to two days can be granted only once in a month by HOD.
3. Students should apply for leave on medical grounds within three days of falling ill and leave application should be accompanied by a medical certificate (from registered medical practitioner). The students must clearly write their Roll No, Name, Semester, and Discipline on leave application. The application must be signed by the parents, verified by the HOD of the department before submission to the Principal Office for further consideration.
4. Medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner duly endorsed by the Controller of Examination is required, if a student fails to take an exam due to medical reasons.



COLLEGE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

1. The Disciplinary Committee comprising the Principal & the senior faculty members assist in maintaining the academic atmosphere and discipline of the college.
2. It also ensures that students follow the rules and regulations stated in the prospectus.
3. All issues concerning college discipline, hostel, canteen, and library are presented before the committee and its decision is considered as final.

Note: The cases of malpractice during examinations are forwarded to LCWU by the college disciplinary committee.

PROCTORIAL BOARD

To maintain discipline and peaceful academic atmosphere of the College, there is a Proctorial Board comprising, the Principal, Vice Principal, Ms. Sabeen Ihtesham and Senior Associate faculty. Cases of violation of the following rules will be reported to Proctor room for appropriate action.

1. Students are expected to maintain cleanliness in the college campus as well as in the hostel.
2. Students should not move about or talk in the verandahs and corridors, so that there would be no disturbance in the class-rooms.
3. Students are not allowed in the administrative offices or staff rooms without permission.
4. Students must be punctual and regular in:
 - a. Attendance in lectures/classes.
 - b. Payment of college fee in time.
 - c. Submission of issued Library books.
 - d. Taking class tests.
5. Students are not allowed to see their visitors or bring them in the college during academic hours.
6. Students are not allowed to leave the college premises during academic hours.
7. Students are not allowed to celebrate birthday parties during academic hours.
8. Students must read the notice board daily.
9. Students should come to the college in proper uniform.
10. Students are encouraged to participate in the co-curricular activities.
11. They are not allowed to take pictures or record videos of college functions (academic/non-academic) and college building. Legal action can be taken if any student is found violating the said rule.
12. Students are not allowed to bring cameras, MP3 player, hand free and Mobile Phones etc. to the college. Violators will be fined Rs. 1000/-.



13. Any student, who violates the college rules, involves herself in negative activities like strikes or instigates other students for this purpose or blows crackers will be liable to disciplinary action.
14. Every staff member has full right to check students for not observing the above mentioned rules and any report by the staff members will result in disciplinary action.
15. No proctor can collect any fine/fund without the presence of duty officers.
16. The Principal's authority in the college is absolute. She has the power to impose fine or some other appropriate punishment for a breach of college discipline, rudeness to staff, irregularity and disorderly behavior. A serious violation of these rules will render the student liable to be rusticated from the college on the recommendation of the Disciplinary Committee.

Note: These rules are meant to cultivate refined behavior in the students and to bring about a proper disciplined academic atmosphere in the college.

COLLEGE PROCTORS

College Proctors are selected on merit to maintain the college discipline, under the supervision of Proctorial Board. College Proctors along with faculty officers on duty are responsible to:

1. Check student's uniform
2. Report violation of college rules.
3. Maintain college discipline

FACILITIES

1. MEDICAL FACILITIES

The college has a dispensary, offering full time medical facility. In case of medical emergency students can consult the medical staff available in the dispensary for first-aid.

2. STUDENT COUNSELING FACILITY

A Clinical Psychologist offers student counseling for the students in the college.

3. TRANSPORT FACILITIES

Transport facility is available to the students on first come first serve basis. College buses routes are to and from (Faizpur, Burj Attari) and (Kot Abdul Malik, Javed Nagar). Transport dues are revised annually. Students are directed to contact Ms. Samra Shahzadi in the Computer Office to get their bus cards. The cards are issued after the admission for one academic year. The students have to pay full dues to avail the transport facility. The cards of defaulters will be cancelled and re-issued on the payment of fine of Rs/- 100.

4. BANK COUNTER

To facilitate the students, a booth of Bank of Punjab is established in the college premises where only students can deposit the dues/ fee. No Family member (male/female) of the student is allowed to deposit the dues at the college bank counter.

Note: Dues are only paid at college bank counter not in bank branch.

5. LIBRARY

The main library of the college consists of thirty-seven thousand four hundred and thirty-five valuable books (Humanities, Science, Commerce and Computer). Moreover, there are numerous up-to-date magazines, publications and national newspapers which are received regularly in the library.



Students are issued a library card after admission. Two books are issued at a time. Students can visit library according to their designated timetable. Books to different classes are issued turn wise on different days of the week. However, reference books, magazines and newspapers cannot be issued or taken out of the library. The students are fined for late return of the books or in case of losing the book. The result of Final Semester exams will be issued only if the students bring the clearance slip from the Librarian.

HOSTEL FACILITY

The college offers Hostel facility on merit to the students taking admission from the other cities. Students seeking admission in Hostel should submit an application in the college hostel to the college warden. Students must come along with the parents for the interview on notified dates.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR HOSTELLERS

Hostellers are not allowed to go to the Main Office, Main Gates or towards the Academic Building after the college working hours.

1. Hostellers are not allowed to hold any political or religious meetings which are likely to hurt the feelings of any resident.
2. Every hosteller is expected to observe peace, tranquility and calm atmosphere in the hostel and to respect the rights of others.
3. Hostellers must be careful about damaging the hostel property.
4. Hostellers are expected to stay inside the Hostel premises and not to leave the Hostel/college without valid gate pass issued by the warden. If they do so, strict disciplinary action will be taken and their names will be struck off /rusticated from the hostel.
5. The boarding house provides accommodation for all unmarried students subject to the availability of accommodation. Local students are not provided hostel accommodation.
6. Before admission to the hostel, every boarder's parents/ guardian must supply a list of visitors, giving details of names and relationship to the student concerned. Distinction should be clearly made between those permitted to visit the boarder during the visiting days and those allowed to take her home for week-ends and other holidays. This list must be signed by the father/guardian and accompanied by photographs and specimen signatures of the visitors which should not exceed five.
7. Appointment of a local guardian by the father/ guardian is compulsory, otherwise hostel seat will not be granted
8. Hostellers are allowed to visit home for the week-end with the permission of the warden. Gate passes for this purpose are issued only by the Warden on the request of their parents /Guardians.
9. On Saturday and Sunday the Warden permits the hostellers to visit homes with their parents/ guardian but they are required to come back the same day by 6.00 p.m. in summer and by 5.00 p.m. in winter.



10. If the hostellers wish to take leave, the application must be submitted to the Warden three days in advance.
11. They must sign in the departure register before going home.
12. They must sign in the arrival register on return to the hostel.
13. A breach in punctuality on weekends going home facility will result in restriction the next time.
14. If a boarder remains absent from hostel without any information to Warden for three days, her name will be struck off from hostel rolls and she can get readmission in hostel after the payment of Hostel Re-admission fee Rs. 500/- once only during an academic session.
15. Hostellers are required to have their breakfast, lunch, and dinner only in the dining room to keep the atmosphere hygienically neat & clean.
16. Visitors of the boarder are not allowed to stay with them.
17. Any student who violates the hostel rules, leaves the hostel without permission and involves herself in negative activities will render herself liable to disciplinary action. A serious violation of these rules will render her liable to be even expelled from the College.
18. Fee submitted for hostel accommodation is non-refundable

- A separate class would be managed only in case of a more than 20 students, less than 20 students will be merged in Regular Class. The fee will remain the same.

COLLEGE UNIFORM (SELF-SUPPORTING PROGRAM)

- Malaysian Gray kameez, White shalwar
- White dupattas
- Black or Skin coloured socks
- Black Shoes.
- It is compulsory to wear College Cards with the uniform.

The College Cards are issued to all students at the time of admission. Students without college cards will not be allowed to enter the college. They are required to keep their cards with them at all times. If a student fails to produce her card on demand by the teaching staff, she will be fined Rs. 50/-. Refusal to show the card can even entail a heavier fine. In case of loss of cards, a duplicate will be issued on payment of Rs. 100/-
